The Chamber of Commerce of Molise was formally established by Decree of the Italian Ministry of Economic Development on 4th March 2015 and was substantially born on 18th January 2016, through the merger of the two Chambers of Commerce (Campobasso and Isernia) of the Molise region (Italy). It is a public body with 52 employees whose mission is to support and promote the general interests of the entrepreneurial system in the region.

The Chamber pursues its goals also by means of its Special Agency “S.E.R.M” (established in 1987, with the name “Job Creation Molise” which afterwards changed into “SEI – Sviluppo Economico Isernia” and, finally, after the merger of the two Chambers of Commerce of Isernia and Campobasso, changed into “S.E.R.M. - Sviluppo Economico Regione Molise”). The Special Agency S.E.R.M., as a technical operative body supporting the actions of the Chamber, carries out activities of public interest aimed at supporting and developing the local economic system. In particular, it provides the local entrepreneurs with information, training and business and innovation support services and carries out projects at a regional, national and EU level.

The Chamber of Commerce of Molise, therefore, as an institutional body representing enterprises of all economic sectors, is the proper actor having competence and skills to promote and carry out projects, also through its Special Agency S.E.R.M., aimed at developing and supporting the growth of the entrepreneurial system.
